### I. Introduction Community Council Members

- All members of the council were welcomed by Shauna Whitelock, Community Council Chairperson.

### II. Approval Minutes 9-30-2009

- Revision to minutes to reflect Brenda Wilden in attendance. Motion to accept by Sean Quinonez, all approved.

### III. Final Report School Trust Lands 2008-09

- Direct instruction hours extended one hour per week for students enrolled in any non-concurrent enrollment math course. Goal was to increase the number of students which will eventually place into Math 1010. Accomplished goal, increased Algebra II pass rate from 37% 07-08 to 60% 08-09.
- UBSCT math remediation provided for any student needing to take UBSCT Math test. Goal reached 100% pass rate 08-09.

### IV. School Trust Lands 2009-10 Plan

- Continue goals listed in 08-09 trust lands plan.
- In addition, develop a "Critical Reading" class for each junior to increase skills in reading necessary to take most concurrent enrollment courses.

### V. School Calendar 2010-2011 Tentative

- Grad date June 1, 2010.
- Only difference from past is condensed parent teacher conferences. Conferences normally run Monday-Thursday, but in 2010-2011 "Fall Break" is scheduled September 30-October 1, condensing four day conference to three days. This also is different in that there is no compensatory day involved.

## **VI. New Century Scholarship Update**

- Deadline to Apply: January 8, 2010.
- Renewal application only necessary for students currently receiving the scholarship, deadline date also January 8, 2010.
- Students must submit a “Confidential Information Release Form” for parents to access New Century Scholarship records and information for their child
- Projected award amount for 2010-2011 determined April 2010, after conclusion of Legislative Session. 2011-2012 projected award amount will cap at \$5000, which is \$1250 per semester.
- Documentation verifying eligibility due by October 15 each year. Official high school transcript and college transcript plus proof of enrollment of at least 12 college hours per semester required.
- If you complete less than 12 credit hours, you must repay the entire amount you received for that semester and the scholarship may be revoked.
- Deferrals may be approved for military service, humanitarian / religious service, documented medical reasons, or other exigent circumstances; but deferral must be submitted by October 15.

## **VII. Jordan School District Proposed Budget Reduction Options**

- Once Jordan School district split tax revenue on west side significantly declined.
- Projected 29.2 million shortfall for 2010-2011.
- Budget Reduction Options from Board of Education Study Session on November 17, 2009 attached.

## **VIII. School Performance Statistics**

- ACT composite score average is up 1.5 points higher than 2007-2008, average is 23.2.
- College readiness indicators – 37% of seniors meet college readiness in all 4 areas.
- Junior ACT composite scores were very high for first ACT test.

## **IX. Proposed Change in Meeting Schedule Day of Week**

- Proposed change in day of week from Wednesday to Thursday for the balance of 2009-10 school year. All approved.

## **X. Other Business**

- Graduate Fair – Redwood Campus Bookstore March 30-31, 10:00-3:00 pm. Students need to fill out form and pay for college graduation cap and gown. Students are urged to keep receipt and turn in to Principal Jolley for reimbursement.
