

# Ways to earn college credit

## Advanced Placement (AP)

- Inexpensive, \$85 per exam
- No credit for class, just the exam
- With a score of 3 or higher, most exams are worth 6 college credits.

## Concurrent Enrollment (CE)

- Tuition free, just buy books
- College & high school credit
- Course offerings differ at each high school
- CE On Campus Classes  
(Fall, Spring and Summer terms)

## Early Enrollment (EE)

- Pay regular tuition  
(\$417.00 for 3 credit course)
- No financial aid or scholarships
- LOTS of courses to choose from

## Challenge & CLEP Exams

- Inexpensive, challenge exams are \$50 and CLEP are \$85
- Some colleges may not accept
- Each exam awards 3-10 credits
- Students must prepare on their own



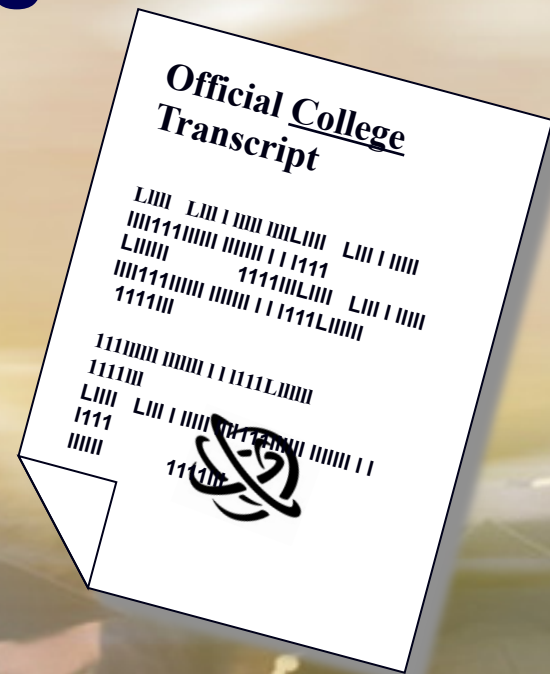
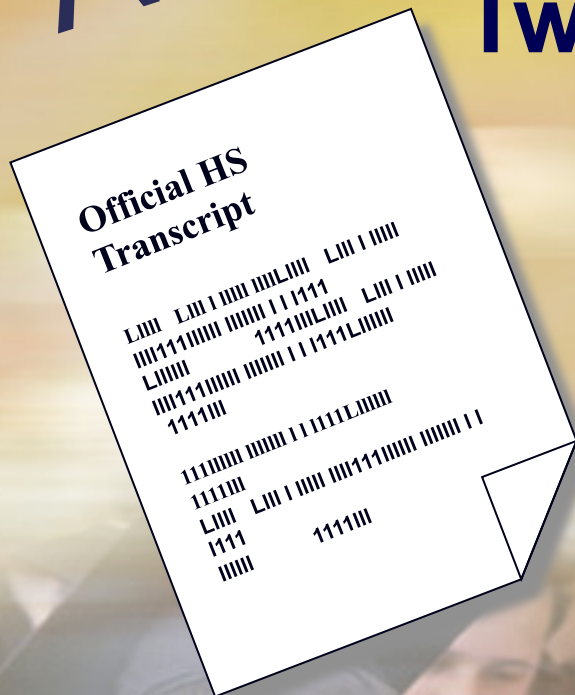

# What if I start to struggle?

- **Talk with your instructor**

- **\*\*There are only TWO people that have control over your grade, YOU and YOUR INSTRUCTOR.**

- Indicates to the instructor that you know you are struggling
    - Shows the instructor that you are motivated to improve.

- **Talk with your HS counselor**

- They can help you determine if you need to drop the course.

\*English 1010- required (minimum) scores: Accuplacer reading of 81, OR ACT reading of 20, OR SAT reading of 520.

\*\*Math 1010- required (minimum) scores: Accuplacer algebra of 54 and reading of 58, OR ACT math of 18 and reading of 16, OR SAT math of 430 and reading of 420.

\*\*\*Early Enrollment- testing into English 1010 and Math 1010 is required to qualify.

\*\*\*\*GPA- both high school and college GPA requirements must be met for the New Century Award. GPA's must be cumulative and will NOT round up.




## ***Which **Pathway** to follow...***

**Pathway 1**- Obtain HS diploma and take some CE courses in high school.

- Take HS courses needed for college readiness and begin building a college transcript.
- Will finish my Associate or Bachelor degree *after* HS.


**Pathway 2** – Obtain HS diploma and complete the **Letter of Completion**.

- Take CE courses Junior and Senior year and in the summer between.
  - Complete 34 core general education requirement.
  - Will finish my Associate or Bachelor degree *after* HS.
- 



# My Options with CE...


**Pathway 3** – Obtain HS diploma and get my **Associate Degree** by high school graduation or shortly after.

- Take CE courses Junior and Senior year and summer between.
  - Able to successfully complete 61 college credits by HS graduation or shortly after.
  - Will move on to my 4 year institution upon completion of my AS degree.
  - May not have the GPA requirements to qualify for the New Century Scholarship .
  - May not have earned enough college credit prior to Senior year to complete degree BY HS graduation.

# ***Pathway 1***

## **College Readiness**


- **Mastering HS curriculum – Preparing for college curriculum and Math 1010 and English 1010 Accuplacer placement.**
  - **Building a college transcript - Taking a few CE courses.**
  - **Coming to SLCC after HS to complete degree.**
    - **Concurrent Enrollment application carries over, so do not need to re-apply.**
    - **SLCC Concurrent Enrollment classes are on SLCC transcript, so you don't need to transfer credits.**
    - **Once you graduate from high school, you become eligible to apply for scholarships and financial aid.**

## **Pathway 2**

### **Letter of Completion**

**May be completed in high school or on campus at SLCC after HS graduation**

- **General Studies core requirements without the elective credits (34 credits)**
  - **Clears General Education requirements at all state schools *(BYU requires the degree to clear the GE requirements)***
  - **The Letter of Completion is EQUAL to one year of college for almost every degree.**
  - **Continue on at SLCC or transfer on to 4 year institution.**

## ***Scholarship Opportunities***

- **There are tremendous number of scholarships for students.**

- **You should apply for any scholarship you are 2/3 qualified for.**
    - **Apply for scholarship in the Summer and Fall of Senior year.**
    - **Apply for 4 year institution in the Summer and Fall of Senior year.**

# Pathway 4

## ***New Century Scholarship Eligible***

- **Created in 1999 by the Utah Legislature**
    - 1999 funding was \$60,000
    - 2005 funding was \$600,000
    - 2008 funding was \$2.1 million
    - 2010 funding was \$4.6 million
  - **Earn your associate degree (2 year) by HS graduation date.**
- And**
- **Minimum 3.0 cumulative college GPA required**
  - **Minimum 3.5 high school GPA required**
  - **Get a scholarship, which will pay a lump sum,\* divided into 4 semesters, for the remaining 2 years or 60 credit hours of study toward a bachelor degree (4 year)**
- \*Amount will depend on Legislative funding from year to year.*
- **Can be used with other scholarships**

# Where can I use this scholarship?

**The scholarship may be used in the state of Utah;**

**At one of the following institutions:**

**Eligible Public Colleges/Universities:**

- **University of Utah**
- **Utah State University**
- **Weber State University**
- **Southern Utah University**
- **Utah Valley University**
- **Dixie State College**

**Eligible Private Colleges/Universities:**

- **Brigham Young University**
- **Westminster College**



# Additional Information

- If you graduate early from high school, New Century still uses your class graduation date
- You have 5 years to use it (if your deferral is approved for mission or military service, etc.)
- Funding is determined by the Utah State Legislature each year

The deadline to complete your associate degree is **Your High School Graduation Date** (June)

Application Available November 1<sup>st</sup> of Senior Year

Application Deadline February 1<sup>st</sup> of Senior Year

# What do I need to do NOW?

- **Work closely with high school counselor and college advisor.**
  - Your high school counselor will ensure that you are meeting your high school graduation requirements.
  - Your college advisor will help you ensure you are meeting your academic goals and make you aware of college requirements, college deadlines, graduation deadlines, grade requirements, transferring of credits, etc.
- **Start thinking about what I want to study or major in?**
- **Start thinking about where do I want to go to school?**
- **Begin planning as early as possible.** Sophomore or Early Junior year is best.
- **Know my options for earning college credit.**
  - AP or IB
  - Concurrent Enrollment
  - Early Enrollment





# What I need to do...

- **Know what classes I am taking or have taken**
  - Are they college level?
  - Does the course have a prerequisite?
  - Does the course have a grade requirement to advance?
  - What was my final grade?
  - Will my grade transfer?
- **Know my SLCC S# so you can access SLCC MyPage and Register for classes at my High School MyPage**
  - View my SLCC transcript each semester!
  - SLCC email account
  - View my college grades
  - Register for on campus courses and pay tuition
- **Create a plan of what classes I will be taking.**
  - **\*\*\*Remember I must LOOK at MY plan.**
  - If you fail to look at your plan;
    - You may miss deadlines.
    - Take the wrong class
    - Forget to take a class
