

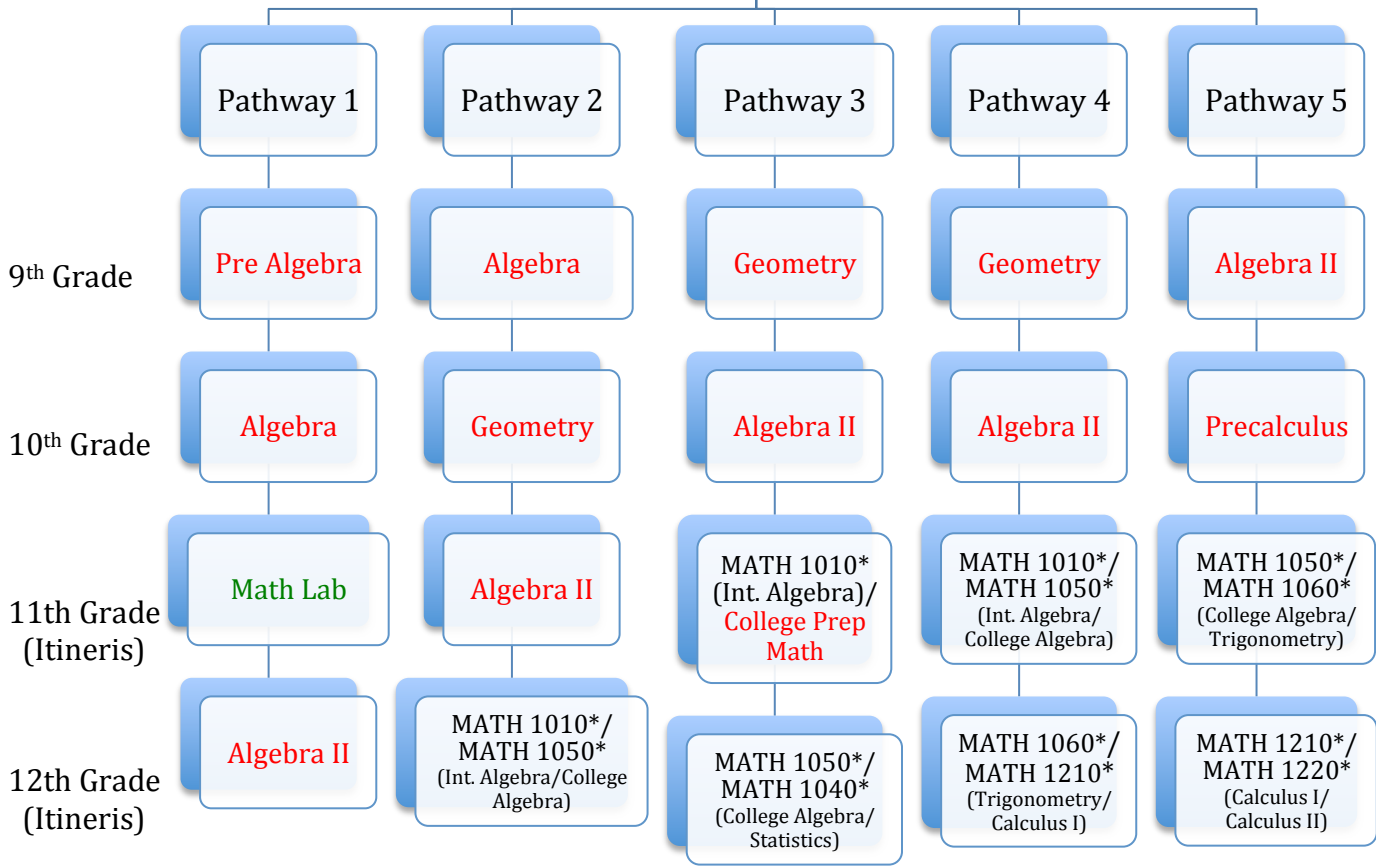
Red font= high school credit only

Math Pathways

Placement in math courses begins with the Accuplacer score (College Placement Test). This test is required by SLCC prior to taking any math courses. After the placement score has been received, final placement is determined by previous courses taken, grades earned, and individual consultations if necessary. Students are most successful in college math courses if they have solid, foundational skills. Our goal is to have every student successfully complete each course and be well prepared for subsequent courses.



Pathway 1:
Geometry must be taken in the summer or via an online course.

Pathway 2:
College Prep Math could be substituted for MATH 1050* during 12th grade spring)

Pathway 3:
MATH 1060* (Trigonometry) could be substituted for MATH 1040* during 12th grade spring

Pathway 4:
MATH 1040* (Statistics) could be substituted for MATH 1210* during 12th grade spring

Pathway 5:
MATH 1040* (statistics) could be substituted for MATH 1220* (or taken with MATH 1220*) during 12th grade spring

*Prerequisite for college math courses is a C or better in preceding math class or appropriate CPT score.
